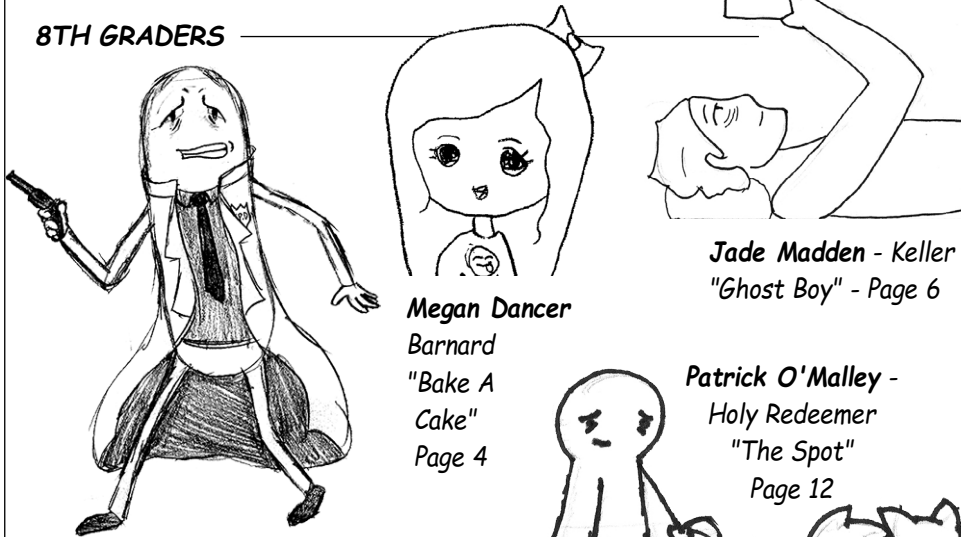
## Welcome to... COMIC BORK 3: THE EMPIRE STRIKES BORK!

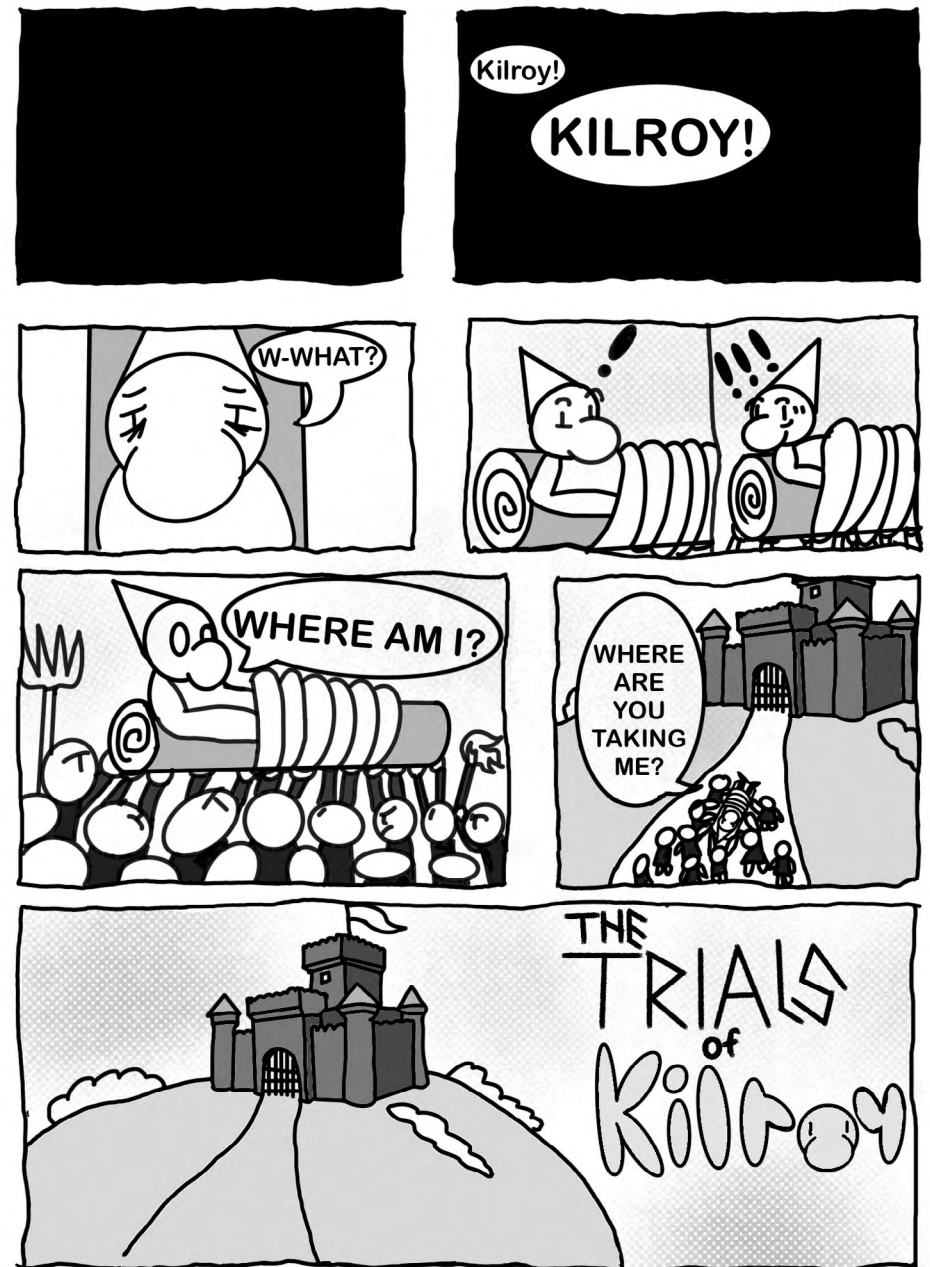
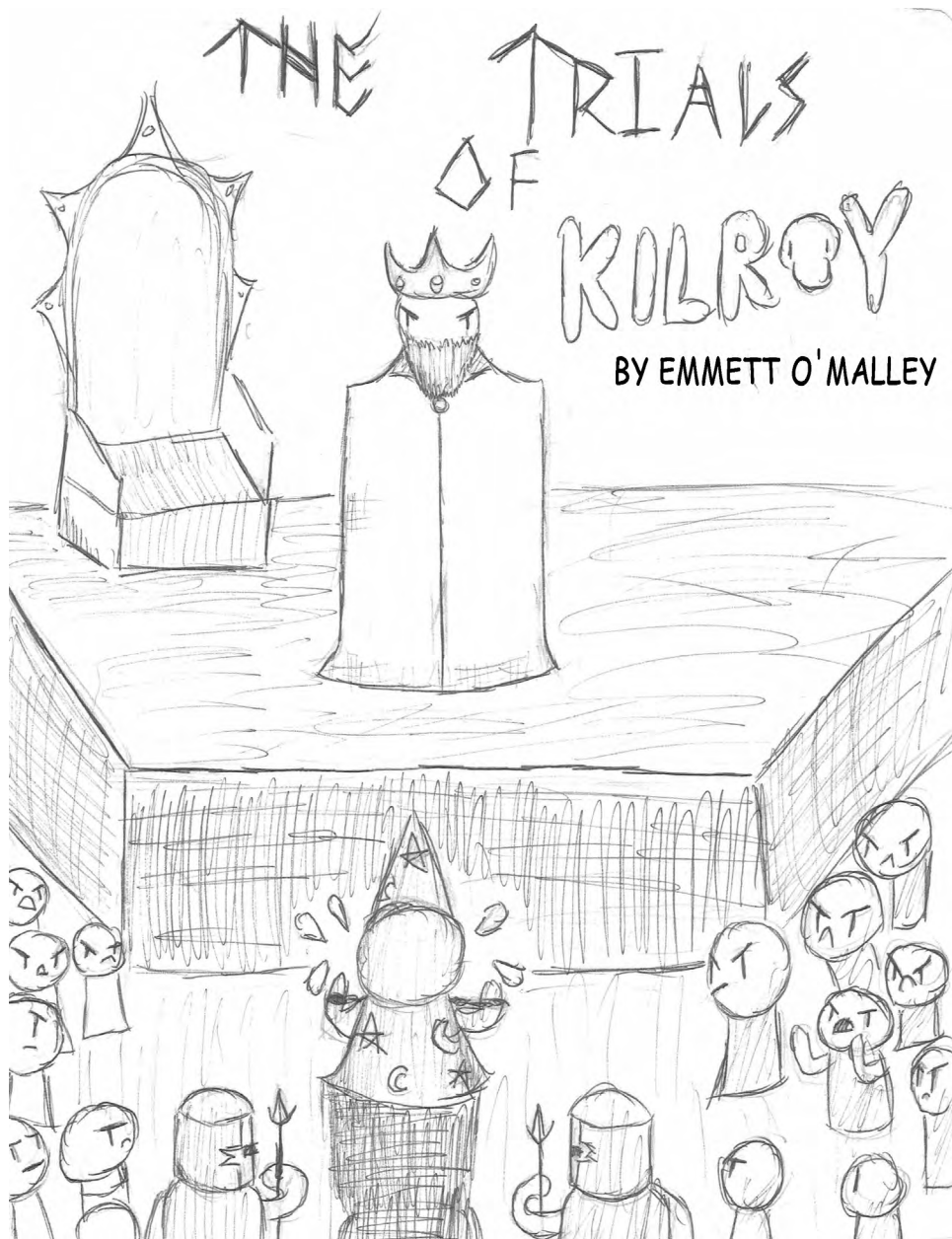




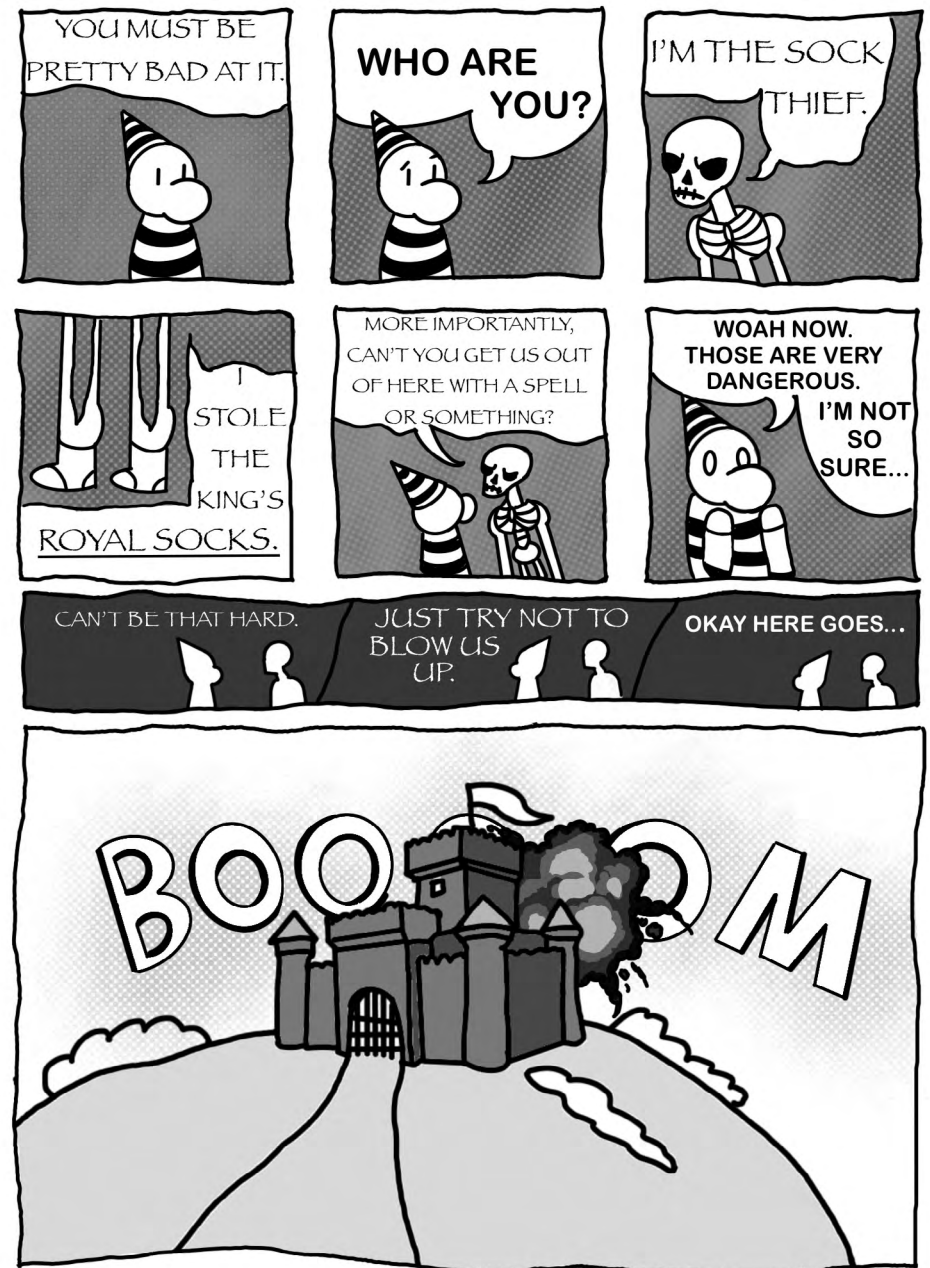
















## Class Highlights

THE VANDERPOEL ART ASSOCIATION was founded in 1913 by friends of John H. Vanderpoel, as a memorial to this celebrated instructor from Chicago's School of the Art Institute.



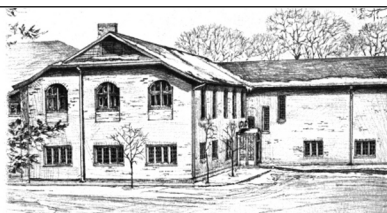
John H. Vanderpoel developed a reputation as one of America's foremost authorities on figure drawing. His book *The Human Figure*, published in 1907, featured many of his pencil and charcoal drawings, and became a standard textbook for art school students. Many of Vanderpoel's original drawings and paintings are displayed at the association's gallery, located in the Ridge Park field house. The collection also includes more than 600 works of art, of which approximately one third are on display in our gallery on a rotating basis.
